






Silesian koloch

We owe our **honey** to hard-working bees which especially like fields and forests of the Kluczbork Land. The discoverer of the secrets of bee life was Roman Catholic priest **Jan Dzierżon Ph.D.** (1811-1906), a world-famous apiarist, born in Łowkowice near Kluczbork. In the Jan Dzierżon Museum you can visit the permanent exhibition devoted to "Old and New Beekeeping".

Kołocz, also called kołacz - a fragrant and delicious symbol of Opole Silesia - has traditions dating back to the Middle Ages. This yeast-raised cake with crumble topping has a buttery smell, a creamy colour and four different flavours. In July 2011, the Silesian kołocz was officially approved by the European Union as a regional product.

The Kluczbork Commune has 35 000 inhabitants, including 23 000 living in Kluczbork and 12 000 in 23 villages. The area of the commune is 217 km², including 12 km² of the town.

Kluczbork has developed extremely intensive foreign contacts. We have partnership agreements with German Bad Dürkheim (2000), Ukrainian Berezhany (2001), Polish Dzierżoniów (2007) and English Wells (2010).

Kluczbork stands for a traditional hospitality which is deeply memorable, moreover it is a perfect place for the active leisure time activities due to 114 km cycling routes, a campsite in Bąków, the "Kluczbork" Reservoir, numerous sports and cultural events and a wealth of traditions of the surrounding towns and villages which attract tourists from different corners of our country as well as Europe. This is a constantly developing town-the latest most important projects are the "Kluczbork" Reservoir,


Sports and Recreation Campus STOBRAWA, the southern ring road of the town, revitalization of the town and the municipal park.

Copernicus of the Hive, the Prince of Bees, these are the names of Jan Dzierżon, born in Łowkowice near Kluczbork, a world-famous apiarist and discoverer of bee secrets. Dzierżon became famous thanks to the theory of the parthenogenesis of bees, announced in 1845, which concerned the reproduction of these insects. He also introduced wooden slats to the hives, which are still used in hives to facilitate the removal of honey. His merits were highly valued by his contemporaries - in 1872 he was awarded **the honoris causa doctorate by the University of Munich**. Many of his personal memorabilia (including letters, diplomas and distinctions) are now presented in the Museum of his name in Kluczbork.

In the park on Byczyńska Street you can see a monument of this outstanding beekeeper, and in Łowkowice you can visit his grave.

The regional museum provides access to cultural property of the Kluczbork Land and the northern Opole Region. There is a permanent exhibition entitled "Old and New Beekeeping". It presents the history of apiculture from the earliest times to the present day, as well as the role and activity of Jan Dzierżon Ph.D.. The flagship of the Museum is an open-air museum located in front of the building, where you can see a collection of contemporary figural hives made by folk artists and sculptors from all over the country. The museum also houses the Centre of Ecological, Beekeeping and Historical Education.



In the Apiary, which is situated in the historical place where Jan Dzierżon (Ph.D.) spent his last years, the most precious honey is produced. The main task of the Apiary is to **breed bee queens for the needs of beekeepers** from all over the country. **It also offers for sale various bee products**, such as honey, meads, pollen, wax, propolis, decorative beeswax candles, cosmetics, as well as beekeeping equipment and articles. The Apiary is open from Monday to Friday from 7:00 to 15:00. On Saturday and Sunday by prior arrangement. Additionally, from 15 May to 30 July on Saturday from 9:00 to 13:00. Within the apiary area there is a manor house in which Jan Dzierżon lived, and next to it, **the open-air beekeeping museum** with trunk and figural beehives. The employees of the Apiary educate adults, youth and children by promoting healthy bee products.

Every year in the second half of August, the "Maciejowskie Miodu Smakowanie" (the honey festival) is held in the Apiary.

The foundation of the town is connected with the **Order of the Crusaders with a red star**, that in **1253** received from the Duke of Wrocław Henry III the permission to locate the town under German law in the place where there was a market settlement mentioned already in 1252 as Cruceburch. However, when the knights failed to locate the town, Prince Henry IV Probus, taking Kluczbork under his care, issued in 1274 the privilege of locating the town. After the death of George Wilhelm - the Prince of Legnica and Brzeg, Kluczbork came under the administration of the Austrian Emperor Leopold I and became a part of the Prussian state. In 1816 the town became the seat of the county authorities.

In the middle of the 19th century the construction of paved roads and railway system began, which made Kluczbork an important railway junction. Evangelicals, Catholics and followers of Judaism lived in the town in harmony. A municipal hospital and a municipal gas company were built, and the "Betania" medical complex was established. A post office and courthouse were erected, a provincial mental institution started to operate.

The end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century witnessed the development of industry. Breweries, printing house, spinning mill, sugar factory, brickyard, furniture factory and a metal products factory were established. After World War I, Kluczbork was located on the border area of the Weimar Republic with Poland. After the division of Upper Silesia, the Kluczbork district remained entirely within the German state until 20 January 1945, when the Soviet troops entered the town. Officially, the Polish authorities took over Kluczbork together with the whole Opole Silesia Province on March 18, 1945.





3 OPOLE ZOO GARDEN (50 km from Kluczbork)

The ZOO garden of Opole is a green oasis of peace and relaxation lying in the city centre among the old trees of Bolko Island. The ZOO covers an area of 20 ha, breeds over 1,000 animals representing about 130 species, offering modern zoogeographic exhibition.
